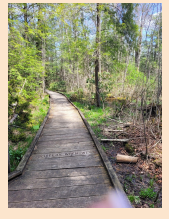
Places to Explore

Cranberry Glades Botanical Area

The best way to reach Cranberry Glades from Snowshoe during warm seasons is by using the Highland Scenic Highway (Route 150), taking U.S. 219 South to Route 55/150 West before Marlinton. This route offers a scenic 30-to-45 minute drive with beautiful views and opportunities to explore nature.

The Cranberry Glades Visitor Center is across the road from where the scenic highway ends, and offers a variety of interactive learning activities for children, as well as live snakes for viewing (including the two venomous species native to WV!)
